The Data Analytics Manager oversees the collection, processing and interpretation of data to guide strategic decision-making. Data typically relates to the education sector, including characteristics of independent schools, school performance, student demographics and government funding.

This role also develops and maintains business intelligence solutions for use by ISQ staff and by independent schools.

Responsibilities

The Data Analytics Manager is responsible for:

- 1. Overseeing the collection and processing of large datasets to ensure accuracy and reliability (e.g. annual student enrolment data).
- 2. Building and maintaining relationships with relevant stakeholders, including government agencies, the Queensland Catholic education system, and associations of independent schools across Australia.
- 3. Ensuring compliance with any limitations on ISQ's handling of specific datasets.
- 4. Developing and maintaining business intelligence solutions for use by ISQ staff and independent schools.
- 5. Developing and implementing strategies to streamline access to contextualized data insights, and to enhance the value of datasets.
- 6. Communicating data insights to independent schools, including the potential impact on future government funding as a result of different scenarios.
- 7. Providing advice to independent schools regarding their compliance obligations relevant to data collection and handling (e.g. enrolment census).
- 8. Supporting ISQ staff to understand data trends and patterns relevant to the education sector (e.g. enrolment trends), to support decision-making, advocacy and representation.
- 9. Managing and mentoring a direct report to support the above activities.
- 10. Delivering ad hoc initiatives as required.
