Before joining BBC, he was Head of School at the Australian International School (AIS) in Singapore, leading its strategic growth. AIS educates students from infancy to Year 12, offering the Australian Curriculum, NSW Higher School Certificate, and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

Mr Casson is known for his future-focused leadership and commitment to preparing students for a globalised world. At BBC, he has led the development of the College's Strategic Plan and Master Plan Campus Vision, a long-term blueprint for innovative learning, co-curricular excellence, and student wellbeing.

He holds a Bachelor of Science from The University of Western Australia, a Diploma of Education from The University of Notre Dame Australia, and is a graduate of the General Management Program at Harvard Business School.
